On **Thursday, November 13th, 2025**, the St. Martin's Parade will take place in *Lannesdorf*. The children of Lyngsberg School are busily selling **raffle tickets** for this event. Please give your child €3, which covers 6 tickets (each ticket costs 50 cents). Every ticket can win! Prizes include gift vouchers for local shops and restaurants. Additional tickets can also be ordered through the school.

Each child has crafted a lantern in class — please ensure it has a light source and is mounted on a lantern stick.

The day begins with a **school church service** at **8:10 a.m.** in the *Herz-Jesu Church*, Lannesdorf. The children of **Class 3a (Bees)** will perform the *Legend of St. Martin*. Parents are warmly invited to attend.

We hope to again provide each class with a large "Weckmann" (traditional sweet bread) to share during the St. Martin's breakfast.

For the evening parade, please meet at 5:15 p.m. on the schoolyard.

Each child should go to their designated lineup area – don't forget the lantern!

The classes will join the parade together and without parents at 5:30 p.m., marching through Lannesdorf. Each class can be recognized by a large sun lantern displaying their class mascot.

The St. Martin's bonfire will be lit on the village square. **Please pick up your child at 6:15 p.m. from the village square.**

If your child is allowed to go home alone after the parade, please provide a written note to the class teacher. A suitable form is included in your child's school folder.
